IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

As part of your registration process, please provide us with the three required forms and a copy of your passport (JPEG format)

- JPG Copy of first page of your passport (see below).

Passport and Visa

Both your Passport and your Bhutan visa must be valid until at least October 12, 2019, which is 6 months from date of entry into Bhutan.

All Bhutanese visas need to be processed by a licensed Bhutanese Tour Operator. Our Bhutanese partner, Ms. Phurba Wangmo from Nangyzer Tours, will apply for visas for all pilgrims. Please upload the scan of the first page of your passport in JPG format (NO PDF OR OTHER FORMATS) with the other forms, as Phurba needs a perfect JPG copy in order to obtain your visa. The JPG scan must be clear, legible, with no reflections, good resolution, and it must be valid until at least October 12, 2019. Phurba will also need to submit your qualification, i.e. degree and subject of graduation, and occupation. The secure upload form referenced above includes input areas for all required information and a file attachment function for the image of the first page of your passport and your signed documents.

Visa for Nepal

Depending on your itinerary, **you will need a visa for Nepal** and possibly for other countries you are transiting. Please make your own arrangements for these. http://nepalembassyusa.org/tourist-visa/

Insurance

We request that each pilgrim purchase travel insurance for this trip. Travel insurance will usually cover baggage loss, delayed flights, medical emergencies and many more useful things. When buying travel insurance be sure that your insurance will cover helicopter evacuation. This would be necessary in case something serious happens with a participant at Taktsang Monastery.

Flights

Our Kathmandu to Paro and back flights will be arranged by our Bhutanese tour operator, Ms. Phurba Wangmo in early 2019. We will post these details on our website and send via email when available.

Please arrive in Kathmandu, Nepal by April 11, 2019 to allow a buffer time. **Please note:** Your online registration form provides fields to enter your flight itinerary to Kathmandu and from Kathmandu, as well as Kathmandu hotel information, special food requirements, and SIM card information if applicable.

Baggage restrictions Bhutan flights

Your baggage limitations for the flights from **Kathmandu** to Paro will be 65 lbs /30 kg for economy class. You can bring two smaller bags both together weighing less than 20 kg.

For carry-on you can have a hand bag and a small bag not weighing more than 15lb / 7 kg. You can pay for excess baggage but please do not bring more than two checked bags.

Recommended Hotel in Kathmandu

To make it easier to coordinate the group we suggest you stay at the <u>Hotel Vajra</u>. If you are staying at a different hotel, please include details in your online registration form.

Packing List

I have attached a packing list, which also includes advice on common traveler diseases and natural remedies for those.

Gifts for hosts

Bring things that are practical like fleece vests, hats, gloves or thermos cups.

Altitude

These are the names and the altitudes of the places where we will spend the night, which is most important for altitude adjustment. Paro: 7382 ft. / 2250m Bumthang: 9185 ft / 2800m DrukZangriKhamar: approx. 8200ft / 2500m Punakha: 4300 ft / 1310m Thimphu: 7710ft / 2350m We will be traveling over passes with altitudes between 9820ft / 3000m to 12460ft / 3800 m.

Water

Nangyzer Tours will provide us with bottled mineral water for the whole trip in Bhutan.

Food

Most of the meals will be served buffet style. The food will not be very spicy. You can add spice if you prefer. There will be seasonal vegetables, rice, spaghetti, meat items, soup ,tea and snacks as well. All three meals per day in Bhutan are included in the package cost *excluding* alcoholic beverages.

If anyone has diet restrictions please provide details in your registration page. I will give the list of special food needs to Phurba. Nangyzer Tours will make arrangements accordingly.

Money

Nangyzer Tours offers to do all money exchange for us. This will save us a lot of time.

- If you change \$100 bills you get a better rate (63) than with smaller bills (less than 59).
- They do NOT accept the \$100 bills from 1996. Please bring only brand new ones.
- All bills have to be really clean, no scribbling on them. Otherwise the bank will not accept them.

We recommend you take at least \$1000.00 in cash for expenses and shopping on the trip. Costs that are not covered by the program fee are alcohol, dana, tips and any personal shopping you wish to do.

- We recommend between \$150 \$500 as dana for monasteries and Lamas that we will be visiting.
- Bigger shops will take credit cards like Mastercard and Visa, most will NOT take American Express.

- Please do not take traveler checks. These can only be handled by banks. We want to avoid group trips to a bank which would take us hours.

- There will be ATMs in Paro, Thimphu, Bumthang and Punakha to withdraw money. Again please do not rely on this as your main way to get Bhutanese currency. We cannot wait for people going to an ATM.

Communication

US cell phone can be used with roaming ONLY if AT&T is your operator. There is the option to get a local SIM card. **Please let me know if you would like Phurba to arrange this for you**. Your phone has to be unlocked to be able to use a SIM card from a different operator.

Nangyzer Tours will arrange the Bhutan telecommunication's SIM for all the guests. Please provide me your phone type or SIM type (micro SIM, mini SIM and regular SIM). I will give Phurba a list of all our necessary information.

Immunizations

Make sure you are up-to-date on routine vaccines before any trip. These vaccines include measlesmumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine, diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis vaccine, varicella (chickenpox) vaccine and polio vaccine. Recommended Immunizations specifically for Bhutan are also Hepatitis A and B as well as Typhoid.

FYI

In lieu of the 5 hr. round trip hike to Tiger's Nest, a horse or mule can be rented for about \$15USD, paid in cash before the ride.
